

SCHOOLS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Schools Committee received one grant proposal for the second half of the 2018 school year. Clernaville Primary School re-submitted the grant proposal it had submitted back in February 2018. At its meeting of March 30, 2018, the

Board adopted the recommendation of the Schools Committee to reject the Clernaville application. The Board directed that the Schools Committee provide guidance to Clernaville on ways it could improve its proposal to ensure favorable Board treatment.

During the 2018 year, the foundation developed a program to assist school officials in identifying resource needs and capturing those needs in grant proposals. Through a series of teleconferences with school officials, the Schools Committee went over the mission of the BBYEF and discussed the types of programs/grant proposals the Foundation would view as consistent to the mission and therefore more likely to be funded. Board President Brender Gregory and Schools Committee member Denise Davidson followed up on these points when they visited the schools this past spring.

The Board will continue to work with each of the schools to identify projects that enhance the learning of the students and make the best use of BBYEF funds.




